Recommendation for Invitation to Membership – Theta Chapter

This form must be filled out completely. The endorsing member(s) needs to mentor this person for a full year – bringing her to meetings, answering questions, encouraging participation in activities, etc.

Requirements for Membership:

“Membership in the Delta Kappa Gamma Society International shall be by invitation. Active members shall be women who possess professional preparation, are currently or have been employed (hired by an employer and/or paid a salary or fee for specific educational services) in educational work at the time of their induction and have had three or more years of experience as professional educators, which includes one – to – one instruction as well as group instruction. An individual becomes a member of the Society when she pays her dues.

Professional Preparation:

Bachelor’s degree with training in education OR certified in her field.

Classification

1. An active member shall be a woman who is or has been employed as a professional educator at the time of her election. An active member shall participate in the activities of the Society.
2. Reserve membership shall be granted only to a member who is unable to participate fully in the activities of the chapter because of physical disability and/or geographic location.
 - a. Reserve status shall be granted by a majority vote of the chapter.
 - b. A reserve member, so requesting, shall be restored to active membership.
3. An honorary member shall be a woman not eligible for active membership who has rendered notable service to education or to women and is elected to honorary membership in recognition of such service.
4. Collegiate members shall be undergraduate or graduate students who meet the following criteria:
 - a. Undergraduate student collegiate members shall
 - (1) be enrolled in an institution offering an education degree and have the intent to continue academically and professionally in the field of education; and
 - (2) be enrolled within the last two years of their undergraduate education degree.
 - b. Graduate student collegiate members shall have graduate standing in an institution offering an education degree and have the intent to continue academically and professionally in the field of education.

When a collegiate member starts her career as a paid educator, she will pay active member dues and become an active member. If a collegiate member does not pursue a career as an educator, her membership will expire upon graduation or withdrawal from the education degree program.
